




Historic


Promotes Fitness


Students are Helpful


Good Morals Taught


Students Enjoy Learning


The School Enjoys Athletics

Musically Gifted Students

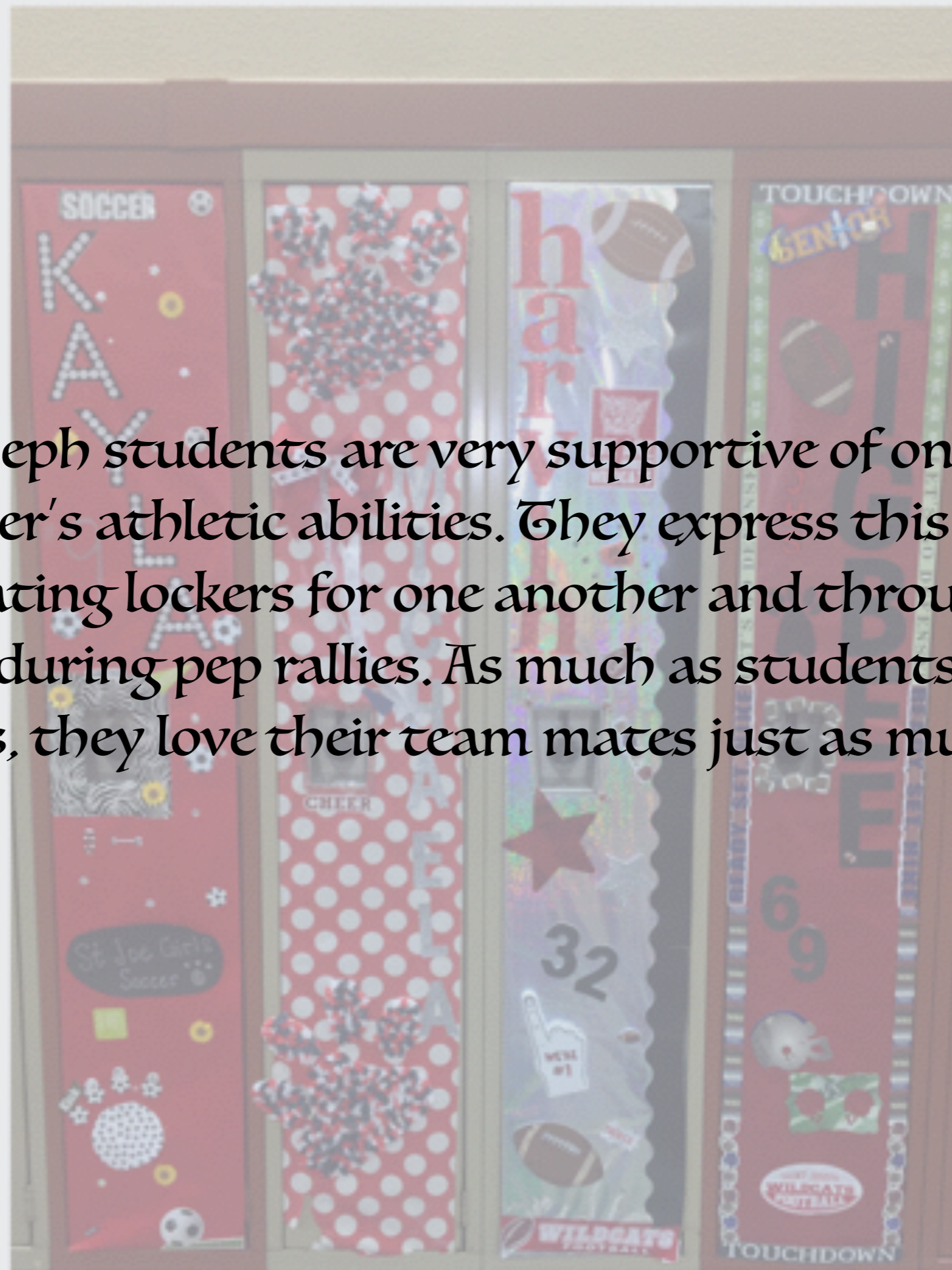


School Spirit
